WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all AGR/Military Technician/Traditional Soldiers in grades **E-4 through E-5** who are members of the Virginia Army National Guard

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must meet all selection criteria IAW NGR 601-1, NGR 600-200, NGR 600-5, AR 600-60, AR 40-501 and AR 135-18.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Reviews and processes enlisted discharges in accordance with (IAW) AR 635-178 and NGR 600-200. Initiates, review and publishes military orders for assignments, duty positions, military occupational specialty, and enlisted transfers within E CO, 429th BSB. Responsible for uploading and maintaining personnel documents in the Interactive Personnel Electronic Records Management System (iPERMS). Process extensions using Retention Management System (RMS) and the Staff Action Tracker System (STAS) for extension waiver. Update personnel and administrative data using Reserve Component Active System (RCAS). Perform other duties as assigned.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- Soldier must be MOSQ within 12 months if not qualified.
Automated Logistical Specialists must possess the following qualifications:
 - (1) A physical demands rating of light.
 - (2) A physical profile of 222222.
 - (3) Qualifying scores.
 - (a) A minimum score of **95 in aptitude area CL** in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002.
 - (b) A minimum score of **92 in aptitude area CL** on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004.
 - (c) A minimum score of **90 in aptitude area CL** on ASVAB tests or administered on and after 1 July 2004.
 - (4) Normal Color vision.
- Incomplete applications submitted for this vacancy announcement will not be considered. Applicants are responsible for maintaining current information on their application.
- **The start date is contingent on availability of funding from NGB**

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested applicants must submit the following documents:

1. Completed NGB Form 34-1 (**signed and dated**).
2. Copies of last **five consecutive** NCOERs. If you are a new e-5 and have not yet received an NCOER, or an E-4, you must submit a letter of recommendation from your **COMMANDER**.
3. Current certified copy of Enlisted Record Brief (ERB).
4. Most recent Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) Record accessible through AKO. The IMR must be dated within the last 12 months to be valid.
5. A Photograph in dress uniform. (**An official DA Photo is not required**). Mobilized applicants may take photo in ACU's; however, you must provide a memo from your Supply SGT, 1SG or Commander as to why you do not have the required uniform.
6. Documentation to support all periods of duty/service creditable for retirement. Any of the following may be used **DD Form 214, DA Form 1506 or NGB Forms 23/23B**).
7. Any additional information the applicant may wish to submit for consideration (i.e., Letters of Recommendation, awards, etc.)

SECURITY CLEARANCE: Position requires a “SECRET” security clearance. Must be able to obtain as a minimum, an “interim” clearance **prior to appointment** to the position. Soldiers with a prior revoked or denied clearance are not eligible for either an interim or a waiver and should not apply. If tentatively selected for a position and soldier cannot be granted an interim clearance prior to appointment to the position, the offer for the position maybe revoked, Non USA citizens are not eligible for a security clearance per DOD 5200.2R.
