WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all AGR/ Military Technician/ Traditional Soldiers in grades O3/ CPT through O4/ MAJ who are members of the Virginia Army National Guard.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsible for representing the Commander, when required. Supervises the main Command Post (CP) operations and displacements. Directs the WMD CST staff and approves all detection, identification and sample collection missions. Meets with a variety of civilian and government agency and senior military leaders to discuss WMD CST concepts, missions and plans WMD CST involvement in state/local WMD response efforts. Implements new policies for WMD CST. Know the Incident Command System (ICS) employed at the state (local) level. When directed, serves as a senior liaison and point of contact with other government agencies and Incident Commanders on consequence management activities. Coordinates with FBI, state and local law enforcement agencies to receive domestic terrorism threat briefings. Ensure a WMD CST member is designated for interagency liaison duty during WMD incidents an exercises. Incorporates a media management concept into WMD CST operations plans. Participates in Federal, state and DoD consequence management or emergency response exercises. Assists the commander to determine the best unit composition to accomplish assigned missions and to provide prerelease technical operations and post release support. Demonstrates the ability to utilize an execution checklist with code words to monitor CB detection, identification and sample collection missions. Prepares, authenticates and publishes the overall tactical Standard Operating procedures (SOP) for the WMD CST. Identifies command and control structures to control WMD CST operations. Recommends task organization and assigning tasks to subordinate elements of the command as directed by the commander. Implements procedures for the introduction of effective new technologies and equipment for the improve protection of the WMD CST mission. Provides sufficient force protection to accomplish the WMD CST mission. Operates in a WMD incident Hot Zone and adheres to mission engineering controls, protective equipment use and work practices to prevent contamination. Establish and maintain an Operations Center.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must meet all selection criteria IAW NGR 601-1, NGR 600-100, NGR 600-5, AR 600-60, NGR 500-3 and AR 135-18.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- Must become qualified as a CBRNE Responder (SQI of "R") NLT 12 months of hire date.
- CST Members are required to maintain 24/7/365 availability to respond to a no-notice alert IAW state and national response requirements.
- Applicant must meet OSHA standards for wearing personal protective equipment (including respiratory screening).
- Must relocate and reside within 50 miles of Ft. Pickett, Blackstone.
- Applicant must demonstrate the ability to pass appropriate ARNG physical fitness test, meet height/weight standards, and present a professional and military appearance.

- Applicant must possess or be able to possess and maintain government travel card.
- Period of initial AGR tour is no less than 3 years.
- All qualified applicants will receive consideration for the position without discrimination for any non-merit reason(s) such as age, race, religion, gender, ethnic origin or non-disqualifying disability. Pre-selection is not only counter-productive to effective recruitment and placement, but also violates Virginia National Guard Placement principles and will not be tolerated.
- Applicant start is contingent on NGB funding.
- Applicants must be eligible to complete 20 of years of Active Federal Service before their MRD.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Military Education: As required by the appropriate grade.
- Civilian Education: Bachelor's degree required. Master's degree preferred but not required.
- Security Clearance: Must be current no EXCEPTIONS.
- Experience: Previous command experience and Battalion staff level assignment.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested applicants must submit the following documents:

1. Completed NGB Form 34-1 (**signed and dated**).
2. Copies of last **five consecutive** NCOERs and all DA Form 1059s.
3. Current certified copy of Officer Record Brief (ERB).
4. Copy of current Individual Medical Readiness
5. **DA photo taken within 12 months.**
6. Documentation to support all periods of duty/service creditable for retirement. Any of the following may be used **DD Form 214, DA Form 1506 or NGB Forms 23/23B.**
7. Last 3 years of DA Form 705 (include all DA Form 705 (include all DA Forms 3349, if applicable).
8. Current Height and Weight Statement
9. Any additional information the applicant may wish to submit for consideration (e.g., Letters of Recommendation, awards, etc.)
