WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all AGR/Military Technician/Traditional Soldiers in grades **E-4 through E-5** who are members of the Virginia Army National Guard.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must meet all selection criteria IAW NGR 601-1, NGR 600-200, NGR 600-5, AR 600-60, and AR 135-18.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The purpose of this position is to develop and administer a unit training program to enhance training and improve the mobilization readiness status of the unit. As such is responsible for accomplishing the commander's plans and programs to attain the unit's training and mobilization readiness objectives. Reviews and processes enlisted discharges IAW AR 635-178 and NGR 600-200. Initiates, review and publishes military orders for assignments, duty position qualifications, military occupational specialty and enlisted transfers. Reviews and process awards IAW AR 600-8-22. Maintain the unit MOS qualification training program. Advises enlisted personnel on military education requirements and prepares applications for Army service schools and extension courses. Maintains records for programs, monitors the progress of enlisted personnel and provides qualification information to the personnel section for personnel records updating. Reviews and processes personnel and administrative documents Interactive Personnel Electronic Records Management System (iPERMS); which requires you to update Standard Installation Division/Personnel System (SIDPERS). Processes extensions on Retention Management Systems (RMS). Review and submit extension waivers to G1 on Staff Action Tracker System (SATS). Updates personnel and administrative data using Reserve Component Active System (RCAS). Perform duties as assigned.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- Soldier must complete formal training by the auspices of USA Infantry School within 12 months if not qualified.
Infantryman must possess the following qualifications:
 - (1) A physical demands rating of very heavy.
 - (2) A physical profile of 111221.
 - (3) Color discrimination of red/green
 - (4) Correctable Vision of 20/20 in one eye; 20/100 in the other eye
 - (5) Qualifying scores.
 - (a) A minimum score of **90 in aptitude area CO** Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002.
 - (b) A minimum score of **87 in aptitude area CO** on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002
- Incomplete applications submitted for this vacancy announcement will not be considered. Applicants are responsible for maintaining current information on their application. Failure to provide current information may result in non-referral for consideration.
- **The start date is contingent on availability of funding from NGB**

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested applicants must submit the following documents:

1. Completed NGB Form 34-1 (**signed and dated**).
2. Copies of last **five consecutive** NCOERs. If you are a new E-5 and have not yet received an NCOER, or an E-4, you must submit a letter of recommendation from your **COMMANDER**.
3. Current certified copy of Enlisted Record Brief (ERB).

4. Most recent Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) Record accessible through AKO. The IMR must be dated within the last 12 months to be valid.
5. Photo in dress uniform. **(An official DA Photo is NOT required)**. Mobilized applicants may take photo in ACU's or OCP's. Photo may be taken in ACU's or OCP's if applicant has not been issued ASU's; however, you must provide a memo from your Supply SGT, 1SG or Commander as to why you do not have the required uniform.
6. Documentation to support all periods of duty/service creditable for retirement. Any of the following may be used **DD Form 214, DA Form 1506 or NGB Forms 23/23B**
7. Any additional information the applicant may wish to submit for consideration (i.e., Letters of Recommendation, awards, etc.)

SECURITY CLEARANCE: Position requires a "SECRET" security clearance. Must be able to obtain as a minimum, an "interim" clearance **prior to appointment** to the position. Soldiers with a prior revoked or denied clearance are not eligible for either an interim or a waiver and should not apply. If tentatively selected for a position and soldier cannot be granted an interim clearance prior to appointment to the position, the offer for the position maybe revoked, Non USA citizens are not eligible for a security clearance per DOD 5200.2R.
