

CRITICAL NATURAL RESOURCES

THERE ARE NUMEROUS THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES ON FORT PICKETT INCLUDING THE BALD EAGLE, MICHAUX'S SUMAC, MONARCH BUTTERFLY, ROANOKE LOGPERCH, ETC.

ANY HARASSING OR TAKING OF ENDANGERED SPECIES OR PLANT LIFE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. THERE IS A MYRIAD OF WILDLIFE IN THE AREA, LEAVE THEM ALONE AND THEY WILL LEAVE YOU ALONE!



DO NOT CUT ANY STANDING TREES OR BUSHES. ONLY USE DOWNED TIMBER FOR COVER AND CONCEALMENT.

COMMON TICKS

WHERE: Widely distributed in the southeastern and eastern United States. RISK: The greatest risk of being bitten exists in the spring,

summer, and fall.

However, adults may be out searching for a host any time winter temperatures are above freezing.

The nymph and adult females most frequently bite humans and transmit disease.



(Gulf Coast Tick)

Transmits: Rickettsia parkeri rickettsiosis
(Tide Water Spotted Fever)



Dermacentor variabilis
(American Dog Tick)
Transmits: Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, & Tularemia



(Blacklegged Tick- Deer Tick)
Transmits: Lyme Disease, anaplasmosis,
babesiosis, & Powassan disease.



Amblyomma americanum (Lone Star Tick) Transmits: ehrlichiosos, tularemia, & Stari


PREVENTION

- 1.Use repellent that contains 20 percent or more DEET, picaridin, or IR3535 on exposed skin for protection that lasts several hours. Use products that contain permethrin on clothing/gear. Treat clothing and gear, such as boots, pants, socks and tents with products containing 0.5% permethrin. Additional repellent options are available.
- Check for ticks daily, especially under the arms, in and around the ears, inside the belly button, behind the knees, between the legs, around the waist, and on the hairline and scalp.
- Shower soon after being outdoors.

TICK REMOVAL

- 1.Use fine-tipped tweezers to grasp the tick as close to the skin's surface as possible. You may use specialized tick removal tools, if you already have them. The key is to remove the tick as soon as possible. Avoid folklore remedies such as using nail polish, petroleum jelly, or heat to make the tick detach from the skin.
- 2.Pull upward with steady, even pressure. Don't twist or jerk the tick; this can cause the mouth-parts to break off and remain in the skin. If this happens, remove the mouth-parts with clean tweezers. If you are unable to remove the mouth parts easily, leave them alone and let the skin heal.
- After removing the tick, thoroughly clean the bite area and your hands with rubbing alcohol, an iodine scrub, or soap and water.

RED IMPORTED FIRE ANTS IN VIRGINIA



RIFA is found in 25 cities and counties in Virginia, predominantly located in the southeast and on the southern border of the state.

AVOID FIRE ANT STINGS; Imported fire ants (Solenopsis invicto) are an increasing concern as fire ants expand their range in Virginia.



EXERCISE PERSONAL SAFETY

SECURE THE AREA

- Restrict access
- Remove ignition sources
- Provide passive ventilation

NOTIFY SUPERVISOR

AND OTHER AGENCIES AS REQUIRED BELOW

CONTAIN AND CONTROL THE SPILL

- 1. STOP THE SOURCE: turn off valve, upright overturned containers
- 2. PROTECT NEARBY STORM OR FLOOR DRAINS: cover with protective mats, lay barrier around drain
- 3. CONTAIN AND PREVENT OVERLAND FLOW OF MATERIAL: surround with absorbent material and place absorbent socks/booms downgradient of spill

CLEAN UP SPILLED MATERIAL

- Don personal protective equipment such as gloves or goggles
- Inside: sweep up saturated absorbent and spilled materials
- Outside: excavate visually contaminated soil/gravel
- Place in smallest necessary container

- ABSORBENT SOCKS
- ABSORBENT PADS AND PILLOWS
- GRANULAR ABSORBENT
- SPARK PROOF SHOVEL
- PUSH BROOM
- TWO SETS OF APRONS, GLOVES, FACE SHIELDS AND BOOT COVERS
- WASTE BAG/HAZARDOUS WASTE BAG

CENTRALIZED WASH RACKS

ON THE WASH RACK NEVER:

- NEVER USE SOAP, CHEMICALS, OR STEAM CLEANERS
- NEVER WASH ENGINE BLOCKS
- NEVER POUR CHEMICALS OR OIL INTO THE DRAIN
